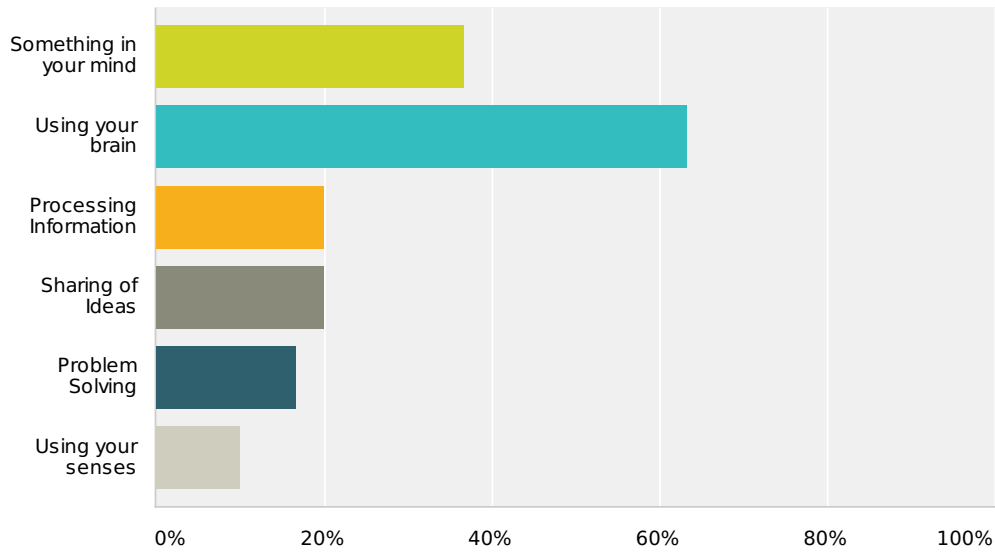


Q1 What is thinking?

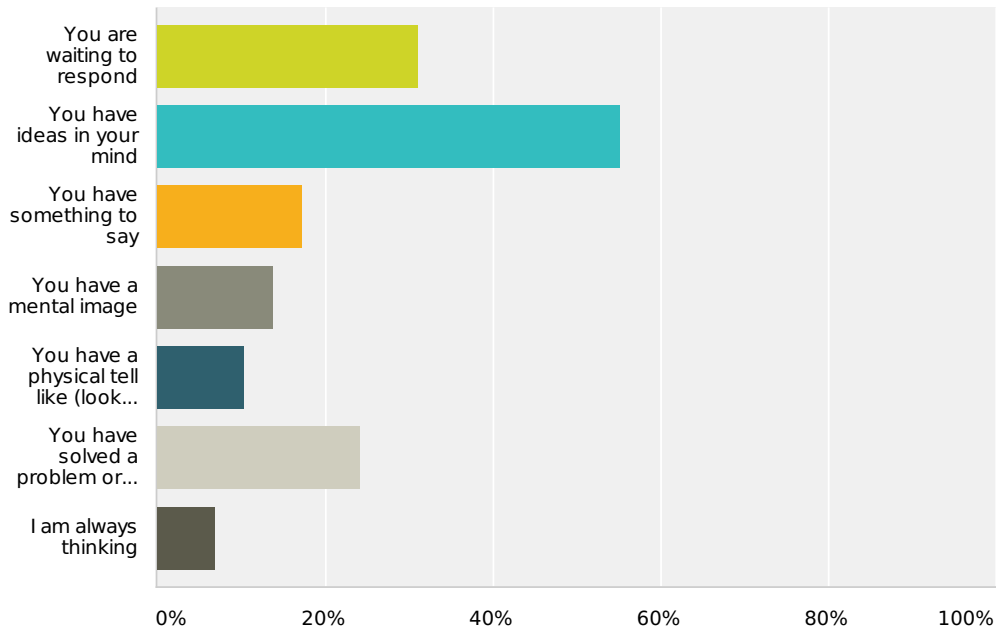

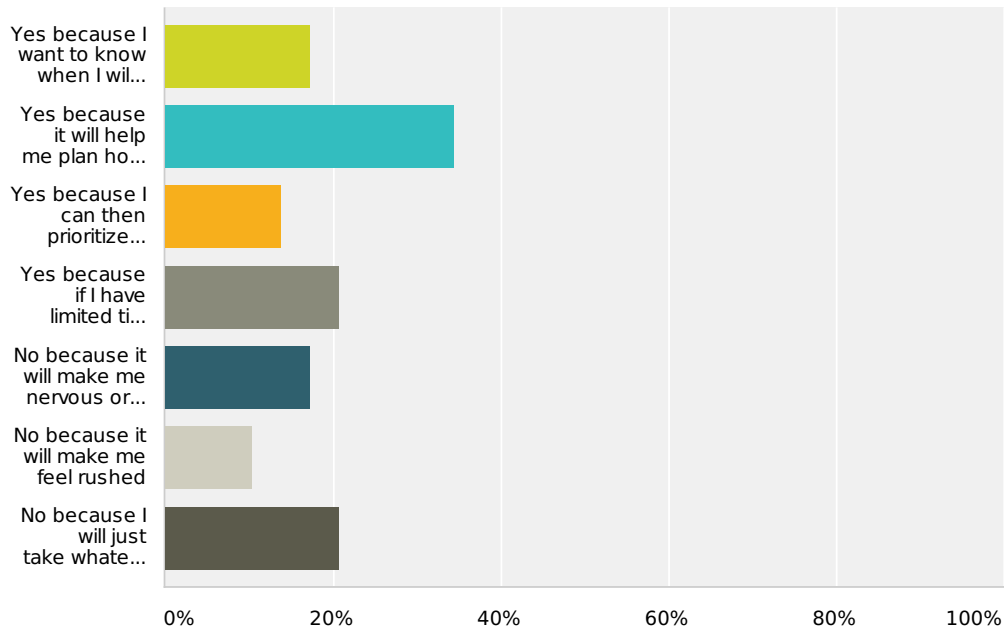

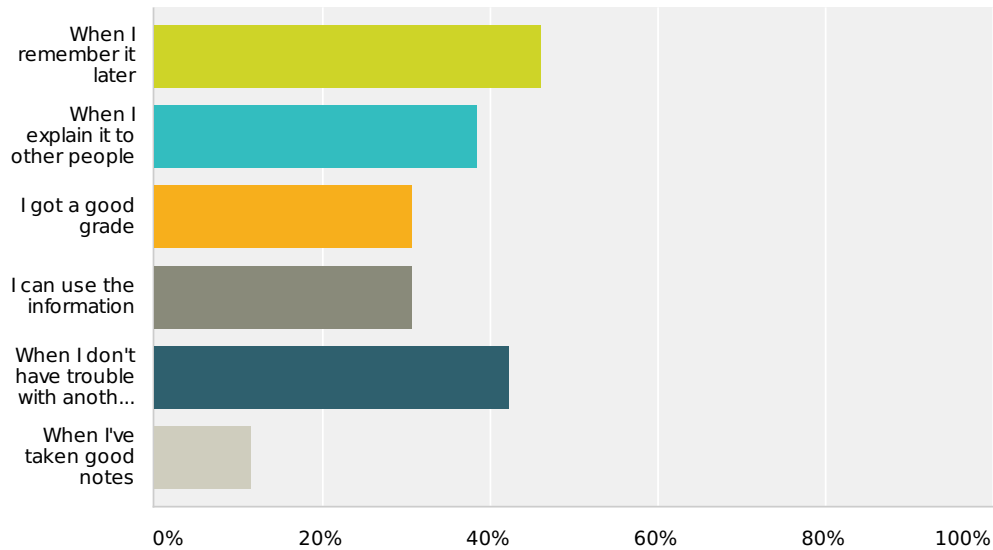

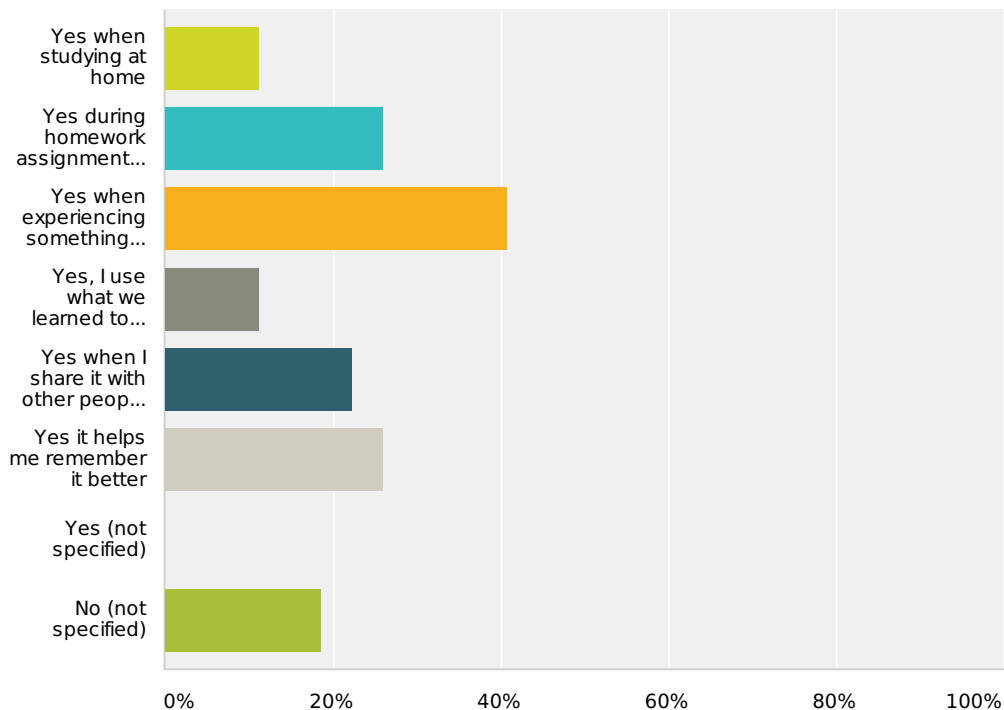

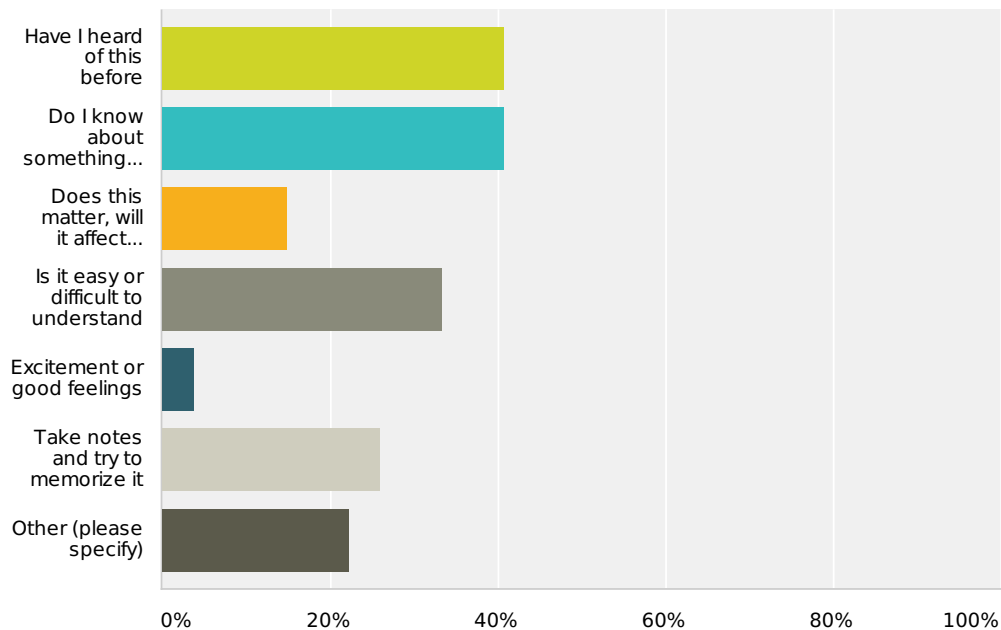

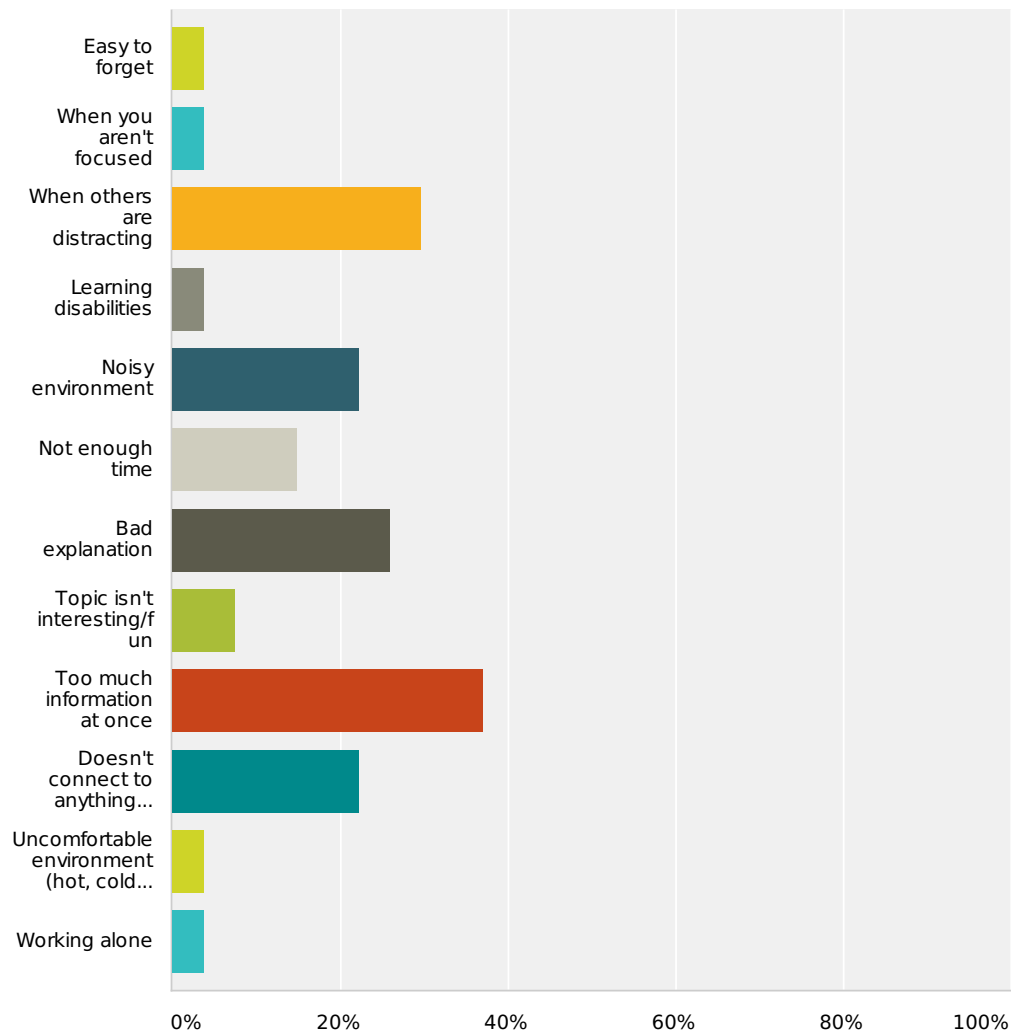

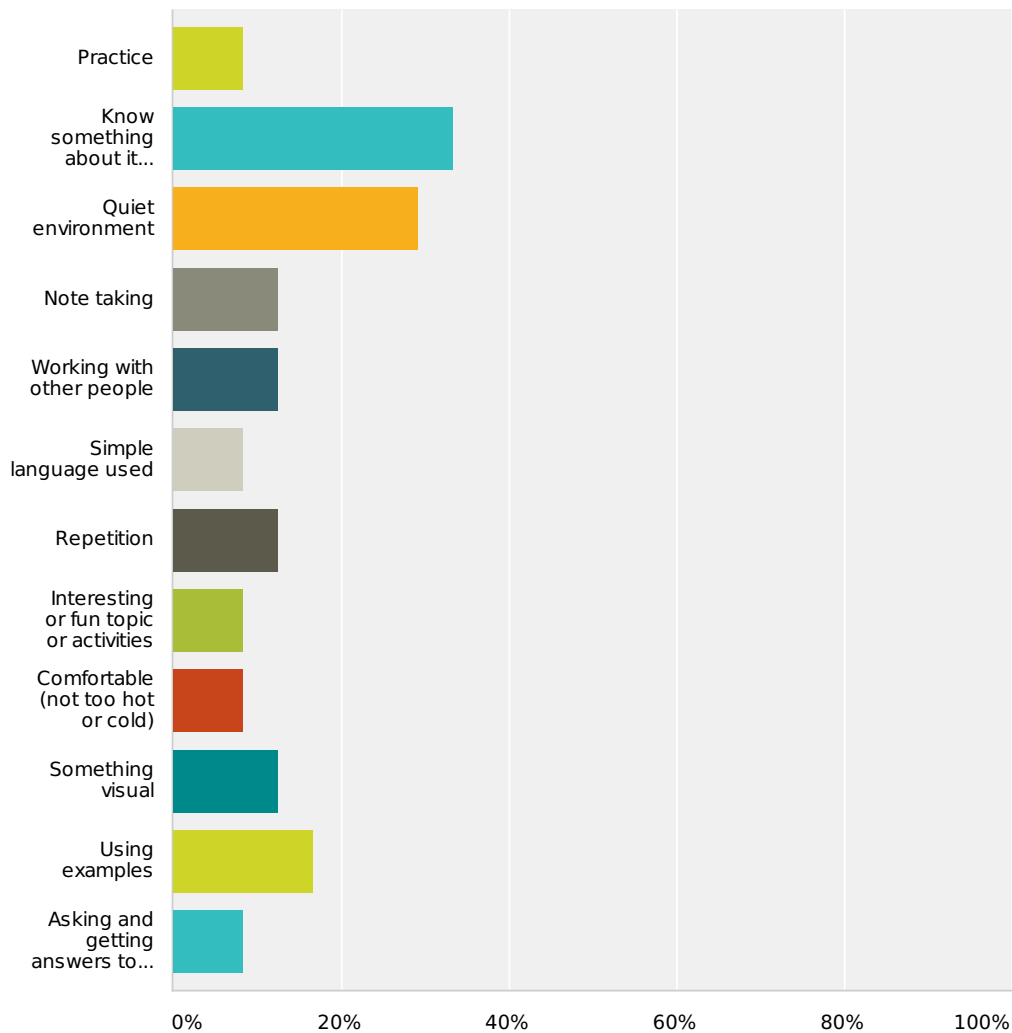
